Nu Deco Ensemble: Co-founded by conductor Jacomo Bairos and composer Sam Hyken, Nu Deco Ensemble is Miami's genre-bending 21st century orchestra that seeks to inspire, enrich and connect new and diverse audiences and artists. Since its founding in 2014, Nu Deco has brought their unique classical music experiences to over 10,000 younger and more diverse audience members in Miami. Combining new music by some of today's most well-known living classical composers, with musical explorations of some of this century's favorite popular artists such as Prince, Radiohead, David Bowie, and Daft Punk, and diverse musical collaborators such as Kishi Bashi, Danay Suarez, Project Trio, Emily King, Nu Deco aims to bring Miami's music scene to national attention.

Andy Akiho: Described as "mold-breaking," "alert and alive," "dramatic," and "vital" by The New York Times, Andy Akiho is an eclectic composer and performer of contemporary classical music. Recent engagements include commissioned premieres by the New York Philharmonic, National Symphony Orchestra, Shanghai Symphony Orchestra, and Carnegie Hall's Ensemble ACJW; a performance with the Los Angeles Philharmonic; and three concerts at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC. Additionally, his compositions have been featured on PBS's "News Hour with Jim Lehrer" and by organizations such as Bang on a Can, American Composers Forum, and The Society for New Music.

Nu Deco: Nucleus brings the high-level artistry of Nu Deco Ensemble in a smaller, electrifying chamber musical experience. Combining the genre-bending musical experiences of Nu Deco with the eclectic genius of Andy Akiho, this performance will feature music spanning all genres from classical, pop, rock, and everything in between.
